

Porcupine Mountains BLOG Post

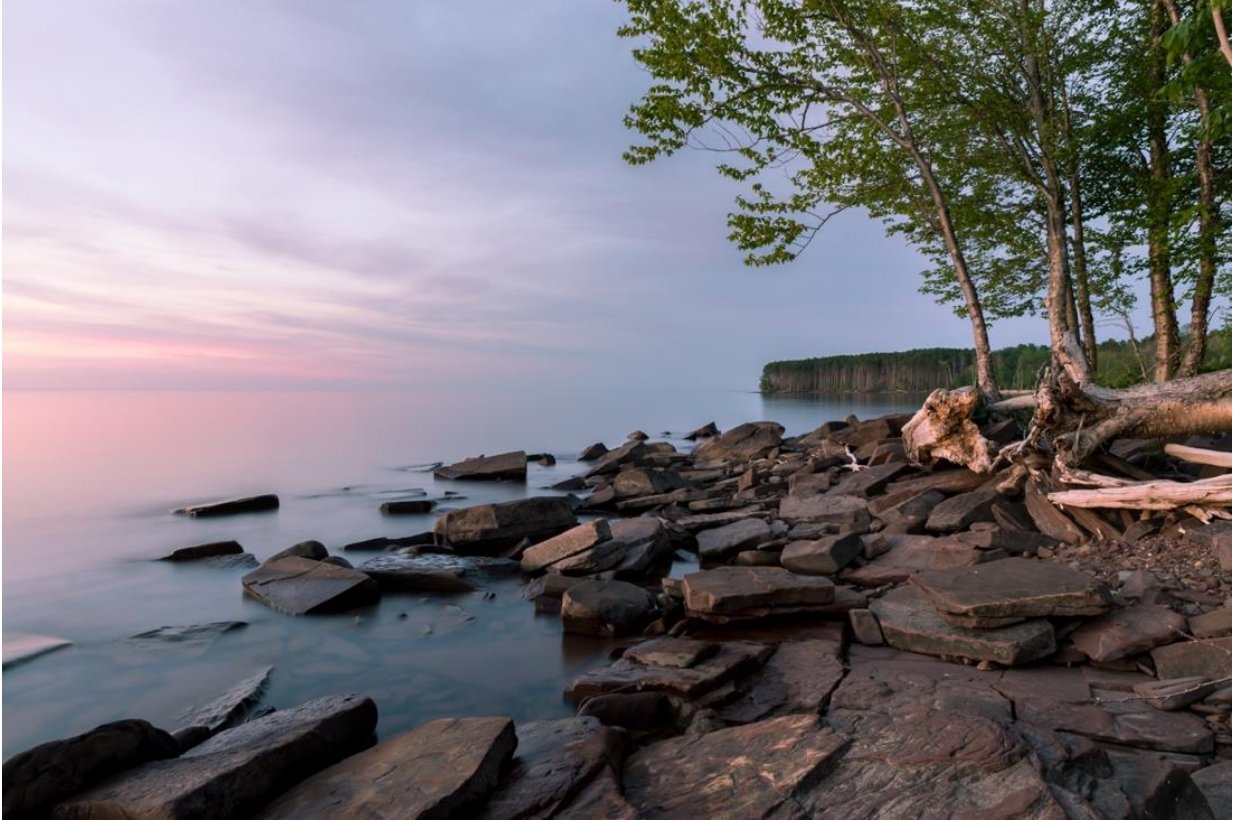

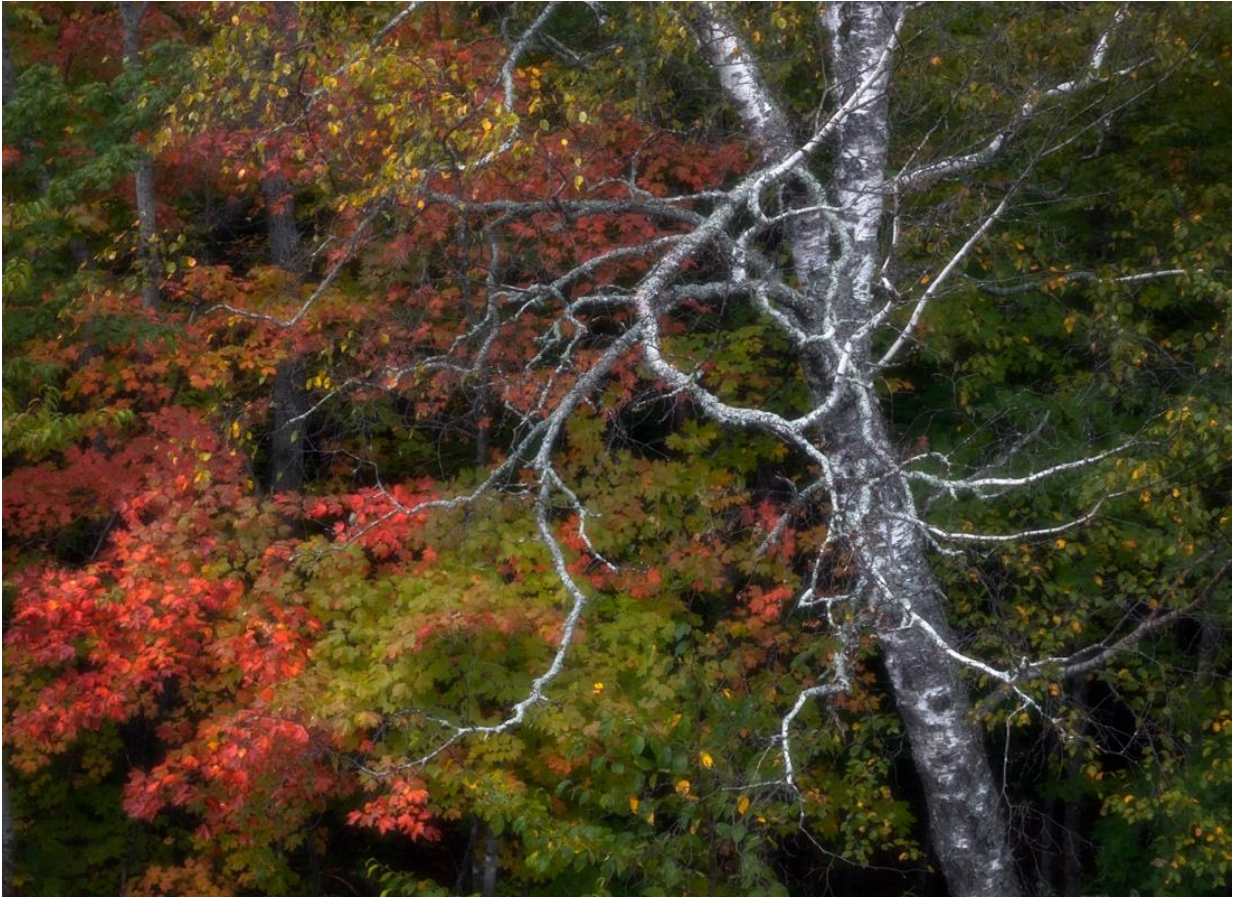
Its soaring granite escarpments and roaring waterfalls descend to the rocky shores of Lake Superior.

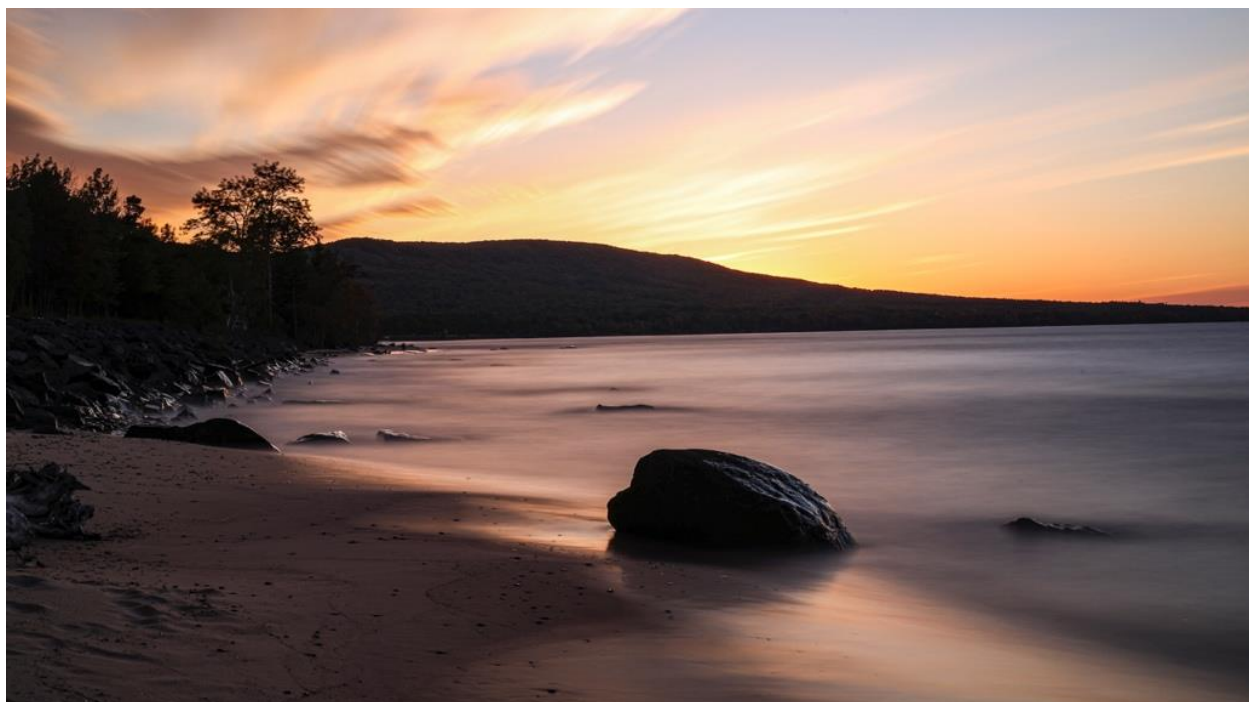

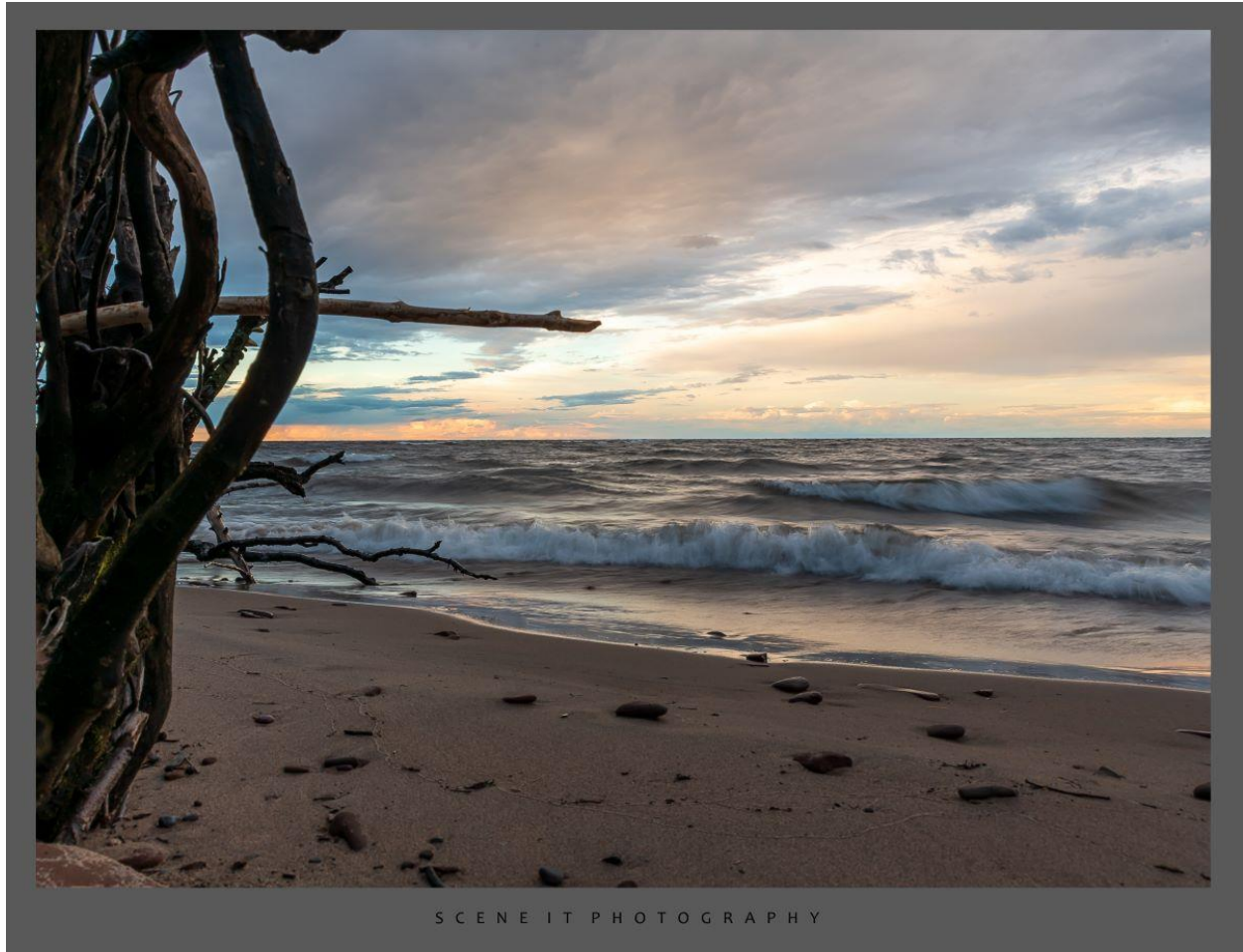

The night skies are dark, if the weather cooperates, we'll shoot the Milky Way or if we get lucky, Aurora Borealis.

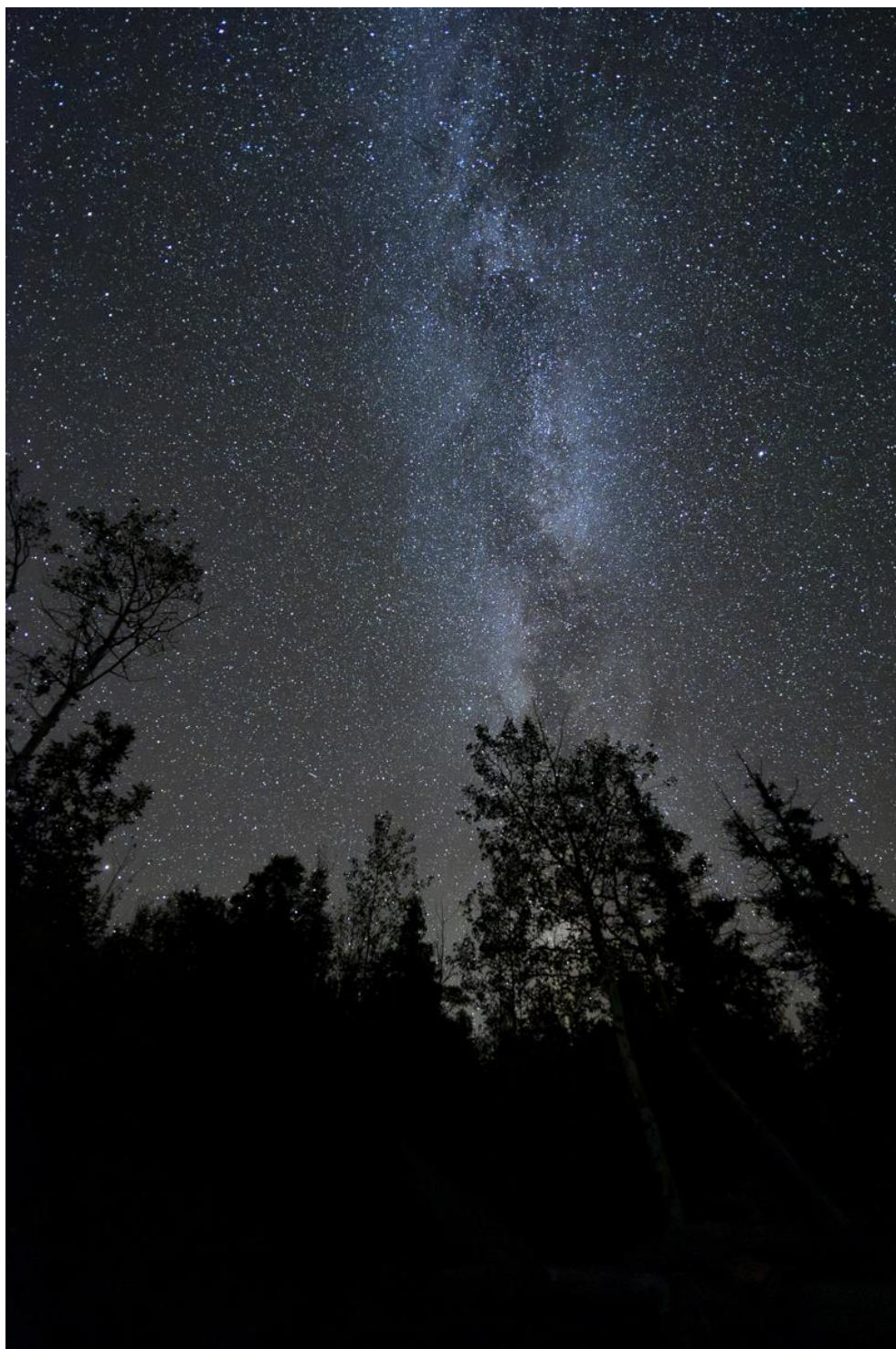

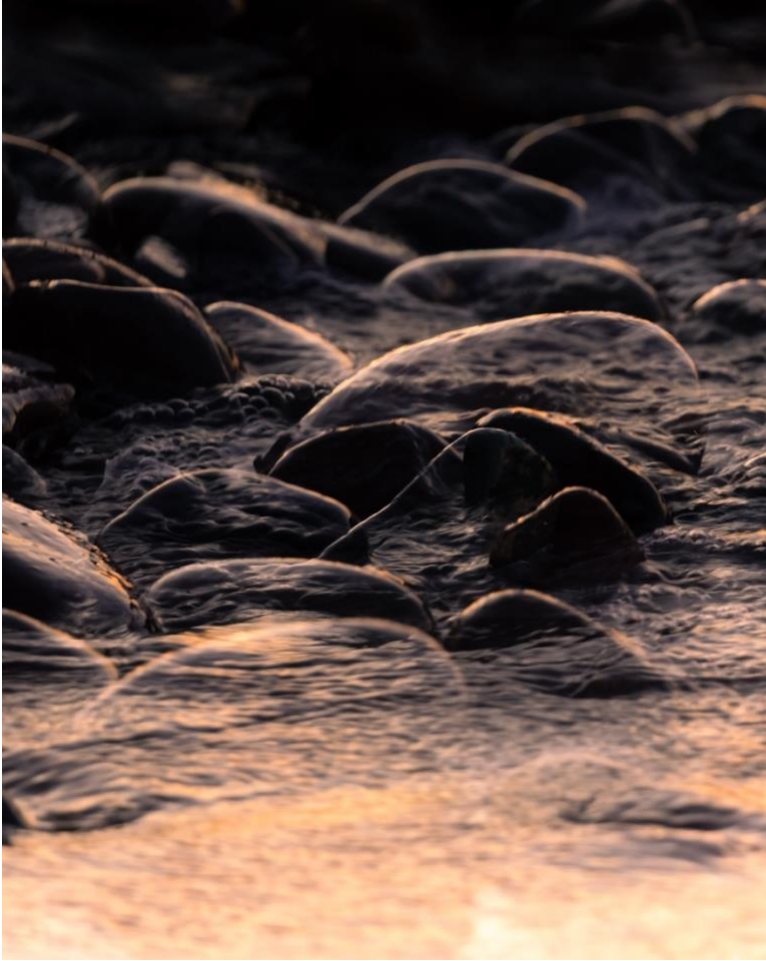


Last year we were treated with an amazing display of Aurora Borealis!
